



## **PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT**

*Now Accepting Applications for the Curry County Citizens' Committee*

The Curry County Board of Commissioners (BOC) invites members of the public to apply for membership to the Citizens' Committee. The purpose of this committee is to identify and explore all viable revenue and expenditure opportunities to achieve fiscal solvency and stability for Curry County Government now and in the future. To that end, Curry County will work in partnership with Oregon Consensus to inform the Citizens' Committee about the County's current fiscal realities and to elicit recommendations and solutions for long-term fiscal sustainability. Membership will be broadly drawn from the community for representation of diverse views and interests of the citizens that reside within our County. Priority will be given to those applicants who represent this diversity as well as those who have a track record of contributing to productive dialog and/or the development of actionable solutions.

Community members who wish to participate in the Citizens' Committee will be charged with examining the County's financial status and contributing to the development of potential options for addressing the County's budgetary shortfalls. The Citizens' Committee will then present these options to the Board of Commissioners for their consideration. Applicants must also be available and willing to participate in the Committee meetings. Appointed committee members are also expected to review and prepare materials for these meetings. Applicants must be willing to serve as representatives for the greater community and be willing to accept input from the general public.
