If the next six months mirror the first six months, it looks like the sheriff won't need about \$200,000 of the Road Funds. Is that likely?

Not likely, the December report does not have a recent purchase of the 4 patrol vehicles the road fund transfer will cover. There will be some savings on the transfer because 3 deputy positions are still open, but the final amount will not be known until 2018-2019 books are closed.

On the same topic, any guesstimate on how much of the \$2,337,017 of Road Funds will the Road Department need just to repair and maintain roads.

Is there an explanation for why planning fee revenue is so low?

The last 3 years planning fees have averaged \$45,900 by December. There was limited staff available during the fall this year, possibly delaying some planning fee activity.
